



Argon Prototypes Inc. Privacy Policy v2

This Privacy Policy of Argon Prototypes spells out the obligations of the Users. This Privacy Policy is in continuation of the Terms of Service of Argon Prototypes; both documents need to be read together.

Argon Prototypes takes your privacy seriously. Our Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect information that applies to our Service and your choices about collecting and using your information.

This Privacy Policy has been developed in compliance with Canada's Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act ("PIPEDA"). PIPEDA sets out rules for the collection, use and disclosure of personal information in the course of commercial activity as defined in the Act. Along with PIPEDA, this privacy policy is also in compliance with Provincial Privacy Laws which are in addition to PIPEDA, such as British Columbia: Personal Information Protection Act; and Alberta: Personal Information Protection Act.

Argon Prototypes shall not (a) be subject to any obligations of confidentiality regarding any User Content except as specified in Argon Prototypes' Privacy Policy, or as otherwise specifically agreed to or required by law; (b) be obligated to pay you or any third party any compensation for any User Content, and (c) be required to respond to any of your submissions as User Content.

We reserve the right to amend our Privacy Policy from time to time and will update the Website with the most recent version. It is your responsibility to review this Privacy Policy to ensure that you are familiar with the most current provisions. If any changes are material, we may provide additional notice and/or an opportunity to "opt-in" as appropriate.

Information Collection

Information shared on the Website by the User while creating a user account

Depending on how the User uses the Services, we may ask the User to share personally identifiable information ("Personal Information") with us along with the information about the part they intend to get manufactured. Personal information includes any information that identifies or can be used to identify, contact or locate the User. If you choose to contact us via our website, we shall be capturing basic personal information, such as your name and e-mail address.

Information Argon Prototypes Service Collects Automatically

Cookies When you visit websites, your browser may automatically transmit information to these websites throughout the visit. We use "cookies" and equivalent technologies to collect information through our Website. Cookies are small data files stored on your device that act as a unique tag to identify your browser.

Our cookies do not, by themselves, contain Personal Information, and we do not combine the general information collected through cookies with other Personal Information to tell us who you are. As noted, however, we do use cookies to identify that your web browser has accessed aspects of the Services and may associate that information with your Account if you have one.

Most browsers have an option for turning off the cookie feature, which will prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, as well as (depending on the sophistication of your browser software) allow you to decide on acceptance of each new cookie in a variety of ways. We strongly recommend that you leave cookies active because they enable you to take advantage of the most attractive features of the Services.

This Privacy Policy covers our use of cookies only and does not cover the use of cookies by third parties. We do not control when or how third parties place cookies on your computer. For example, third-party websites to which a link points may set cookies on your computer.

We may use third-party Service Providers to monitor and analyze the use of our Service.

How We Use Your Information

Our primary goal in collecting your information is to provide you with an enhanced experience when using the Services and determine which features we need to improve, including usage patterns.

We also use information that we collect about you or that you provide us:

- To manufacture your parts as per the specifications provided by you.
- Provide the Services you request.
- To provide you with customer support to fulfill our contracts with Users;
- For internal market research for our legitimate interest in improving the Argon Prototypes Service to grow our business.
- For troubleshooting problems for our legitimate interests or verifying the specification provided by you
- As otherwise set forth in the Agreement, to show users' profiles to one another.
- To improve the Customer experience.
- To provide, develop and improve Argon Prototypes and its services, including making assessments and recommendations about the Service.
- To notify about our Website or service changes or any services that we offer or provide through it.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

We may release Personal Information or other information we collect if we believe that such action is necessary to (I) comply with legal requirements and processes; (II) identify, contact or bring legal action against persons or entities who are or we believe have caused or might cause injury to us, or a third party; (III) defend or respond to claims brought or threatened against us, our employees, service providers, users of our Services or others; (IV) vendors, service providers, and technicians who help with some of our processing and storage, including helping to answer your questions; and/or (V) otherwise to protect, assert rights, interests of Argon Prototypes and of our employees, service providers, Users of the Services or others. We may make any such release decisions at our sole discretion.

In addition, since member information on our Website is a business asset, in case we are reorganized or sold to or merged with another company, we may sell, assign, or transfer your personal information to a purchaser of all or substantially all of our business assets, or an affiliate, as applicable.

Information sharing

Third-Party Platforms: To provide you with the best Service Argon Prototypes gets connected to various third-party devices and services. Unless expressly prohibited by a signed non-disclosure agreement (NDA) or some other form of agreement, in order to manufacture the Parts you order via our Services, Argon Prototypes may subcontract a Customer's manufacturing project to one of our Manufacturing Partners. As part of this process, we may share your information such as photos of the manufactured or semi manufactured Part(s) with our Manufacturing Partners to enable them to manufacture the Part(s) or finalise the manufacturing.

How Long Is This Data Stored For?

We will only retain your personal data for so long as we reasonably need to use it for the purposes set out above unless a longer retention period is required by law (for example for regulatory purposes).

Security

We implement and maintain reasonable security appropriate to the nature of the personal information that we collect, use, retain, transfer or otherwise process. Our reasonable security program is implemented and maintained in accordance with applicable laws. Accordingly, while our reasonable security program is designed to manage data security risks and thus help prevent data security incidents and breaches, it cannot be assumed that the occurrence of any given incident or breach results from our failure to implement and maintain reasonable security

User Data Rights

By using our Services and Marketing Activities, you expressly give your consent to collect and use your personal information in compliance with this Privacy Policy. This does not affect lawful processing under applicable laws based on other legal bases such as contractual obligation, compliance with applicable laws, and legitimate purposes.

Child protection

Our Services are not intended for or directed to children. Children under 18 are not eligible to use our Services. Our policies are compliant with the Canadian Child Welfare Research Portal of Canada and Protection Act. By using the Services, you represent that you are at least 18 years old and understand that you must be at least 18 years old to create an account and purchase and use the Services advertised through our platform. We do not knowingly collect or maintain Personal Information from children under the age of 18. If we learn that we have inadvertently gathered Personal Information from children younger than 18, we will take reasonable measures to delete or destroy such information from our records.

Right to Access or Correct Personal Information

Upon receipt of your written request, we will provide you with a copy of your Information, although in certain limited circumstances, we may not be able to make all relevant information available to you, such as where that information also pertains to another user. In such circumstances, we will provide reasons for the denial upon request. We will endeavour to deal with all requests for access and modifications promptly. We will make every reasonable effort to keep your Information accurate and up-to-date, and we will provide you with mechanisms to update, correct, delete or add to your Information as appropriate. As appropriate, this amended Information will be transmitted to those parties to which we can disclose your information.
